Among other items at the meeting we shall:


- Review a financial report, plus an update on the BUGB pension deficit and how this impacts the church.

### New post-Easter preaching series -

#### 'Belonging & becoming the family of God'

~ since January we have been following the story of Jesus in Matthew's Gospel - a story that culminated with the extraordinary resurrection that we celebrate on Easter Sunday. This is a story that involves us all and signifies that our stories have roots in something greater and grander - the story of God. From the 15th April we are going to look at a cross-section of passages of scripture to explore what it is to be church today. We are more than people who sit beside each other on a Sunday morning, so how do we function and contribute to the family of God?



**House groups at GBC** ~ small groups meet regularly at homes and at the church throughout the week with the aim to - find friendship and a sense of belonging, study the Bible on topics that help everyday living, learn how to grow in faith and right living, pray for, support and encourage each other & to pray for the needs of others. **'Into Membership' sessions** ~ Micky will be shortly running some mid-week sessions on aspects of belonging to a Baptist church, GBC in particular. So whether you are new to GBC or not, we trust you will find these sessions a great help in understanding how and why we do the things we do, and what it means to belong to GBC.
