Meetings

<u>A Special Church Meeting</u> is to be held on **Sunday 16th April** at Guiseley Baptist Church, Oxford Road, beginning at 11.30 am, when, under the guidance of the Holy Spirit, the church will discern whether to sell the second manse at 19 Moorland Crescent, Menston, LS29 6AF in order to part-fund the purchase of the property at 24B - 24C Oxford Road, Guiseley, LS20 9AS. These offices and annexe building are adjacent to our chapel.

The purpose for selling and buying will be set out in today's service and again at the meeting.

Our Church Constitution states that the Church can only consider matters relating to the purchase, sale, lease, mortgage, or redevelopment of church property at a Special Church Meeting, convened solely for that purpose.

For the meeting to be quorate we need 50% of the membership to be present. In practice this means that we need 44 members present at the meeting on 16th April to be able to proceed with the marketing and sale of the second manse and the purchase of the adjacent offices and annexe, if that is what is determined by the meeting. If we are not quorate, nothing will proceed.

So, if you are a church member, please put the date in your diary and make every effort to be there. Do not assume that everyone else will turn up! We anticipate the meeting will take no longer than 1 hour.

<u>An AGM and Ordinary Church Meeting</u> will take place on **Tuesday 25th April** at 7:30pm when we will discuss a number of things, including agreeing to the church profile and the profile for a new minister.

If you consider yourself to be a part of GBC, please make every effort to come along and be involved as we make these important decisions.

Calling a new minister to GBC

At our last church meeting in February, members approved a proposal that we seek to appoint a new minister to GBC. To enable this to happen, the church must produce a profile that describes who we are and the ministry we are seeking.

The deacons have been working on developing the profile for some weeks. A draft profile will be ready to share with the whole church by 2nd April 2023. Many of you will receive the draft profile by email, but we will also provide paper copies at church for those who need them.

The deacons will be seeking your feedback to inform the final version of the profile. Deadlines are tight, so **all comments need to be returned no later than 12th April 2023** to Joy Liles, either via email: joy.liles@guiseleybaptistchurch.co.uk or by post: 26 Silverdale Drive, Guiseley, LS20 8BE.

Using your feedback, the deacons will then finalise the profile and seek approval for it at the next church meeting on Tuesday 25th April.

Once the profile is approved, it will be sent to the YBA Regional Minister. The church's vacancy will then be listed in the pastoral vacancy list (PVL) - a secure area on the Baptists Together website. Baptist ministers who have access to the PVL can express their interest in particular vacancies by sending their ministerial profiles to those churches.
