## Alpha Course

As many of you will know from the email from Tony Tofrik, we are going to be holding an Alpha Course to provide an introduction to the Christian faith. This will begin on 25<sup>th</sup> September. The course will last for 12 weeks and needs volunteers for a variety of tasks:
